The View Yarra Valley Chardonnay 2007

Gleaming green straw: a notably complex wine with barrel ferment inputs to intense stone fruit and some citrus flavours: has a compelling length. Diam. 13.5% alc. **Rating 94 Drink 2015 Date Tasted Mar 10**

The Gate Yarra Valley Pinot Noir 2005

Gently foresty overtones to red fruits on the bouquet lead into a long palate which, while savoury, is not bitter, just complex. A pinot drinkers' pinot. Diam. 14% alc. **Rating 94 Drink 2012 Date Tasted Jan 07**

The Gate Yarra Valley Cabernet Sauvignon Merlot 2005

Classic cabernet sauvignon with fine tannins running through from the start of the palate to the finish, almost Italianate in its structure. Needs time to settle down and allow the cabernet currant and cassis fruit to express itself. Diam. 14.5% alc. **Rating 92 Drink 2020 Date Tasted Jan 07**

Heathcote Vineyard Shiraz 2007

Undeniably concentrated with rich and dark, fruitcake-like offerings; the palate is dense and quite chewy, and quite massively proportioned; a big wine, in need of plenty of protein. Diam. 14.5% alc. **Rating 90 Drink 2014 Date Tasted Jan 10**

The View Yarra Valley Pinot Gris 2009

Bright green straw, certain it is, that this is a pinot gris. With attitude and above average structure but it's a challenging wine. Diam. 14.0% alc. **Rating 90 Drink 2013 Date Tasted Jan 11**

Heathcote Vineyard Merlot 2008

Moderate red-purple: an aromatic bouquet leads into an uncompromising palate, with cassis, herb and black olive flavours supported by substantial savoury tannins. 14.0% alc. **Rating 89 Drink 2020 Date Tasted Jan 11**
